

Ozark Snake Farm Additional Information

-Species of snakes raised: Ball pythons, boa constrictor, Burmese Python, reticulated Python, and crested geckos

-Volume of snakes raised/produced annually and quantity to be held on-site at any one time: On average 100 snakes produced annually. Current inventory is 90 snakes but can fluctuate between typically 50-150.

-Size limitations of snakes raised. At what point of maturity in size do the snakes transfer out of the raising facility? the snake we mainly work with and breed is ball pythons. They have a maximum size of about 5ft and a few pounds. Reticulated pythons like the animals we use for school, church, camp war eagle, jones center, etc presentations can reach 6-7 meters. Snakes are typically sold around 12 inches and between 60 and 300 grams, less than a pound.

-Safety Measures for containment during the raising process: snakes are raised in inescapable industry standard reptile racks.

-Storage/raising facility specifications. Building size, location on property, access, arrangement and number cages. Photographs and drawings/sketch will be helpful: we breed in the garage. 20x25 ft. Snakes are kept individually

-Certifications of storage / containment. Not sure

-Emergency plan in case of Fire, tornado or other disaster that could lead to escape of raised reptiles or potential endangerment to emergency responders: in case of emergency snakes would be moved to secure temporary containers and relocated to a safe location
