

ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 24.

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE NO PARKING ALONG WEST GLENWOOD AVENUE BETWEEN THE INTERSECTIONS OF ARKANSAS HIGHWAY 112 AND SOUTH CHESTNUT STREET IN CAVE SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSTING OF "NO PARKING" SIGNS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

on South Side of Glenwood St.

WHEREAS, the City has power to build, construct, maintain, maintain, operate police and control the streets and roadways within the municipal limits of the City of Cave Springs, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the City Council of Cave Springs, Arkansas that there exists traffic circulation problems and hazards due to vehicle parking on West Glenwood Avenue, between the intersections of Arkansas Highway 112 and South Chestnut Street in Cave Springs, which jeopardizes the safety, health and welfare of the citizen of Cave Springs, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, after consideration and deliberation, the City Council of the City of Cave Springs, Arkansas, declares "No Parking" of vehicles in the City of Cave Springs right-of-way on West Glenwood Avenue, between the intersections of Arkansas Highway 112 and South Chestnut Street within the City of Cave Springs and calls for the posting of adequate signs stating "No Parking" along said Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the City Council of the City of Cave Springs, as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Cave Springs, Arkansas, declares "No Parking" of vehicles along the City of Cave Springs right-of-way on West Glenwood Avenue, between the intersections of Arkansas Highway 112 and South Chestnut Street, within the City of Cave Springs.

SECTION 2: Upon posting of said streets or roadways with adequate signs stating "No Parking", and providing for similar limitations, the restrictions provided for shall be in effect.

SECTION 3: The penalty for violation the provisions of this ordinance shall be court costs as established by the Court in setting judgments of said violation, plus an additional penalty not to exceed Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage, and that this Ordinance supersedes and replaces any other Ordinances in conflict herewith. In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance shall for any reason be held by a Court of Law to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision or provisions had never been contained herein.

SECTION 5: It is hereby found and determined that because of the danger posed to the citizens of Cave Springs by the vehicle traffic which is regulated by this Ordinance, the Ordinance is declared necessary to provide adequate protection to the citizens of the City of Cave Springs, Benton County, Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens, shall become effective on the date of its passage and approval by the Mayor. If the Code is neither approved nor vetoed by the Mayor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Mayor may veto the ordinance enacting this Code. If the Code is vetoed by the Mayor and the veto is overridden by the City Council, it shall become effective on the date the City Council overrides the veto.
